### **Proposed Spending of Pupil Premium 2015/16**

**Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) Allocation for 2015/16 is:**

#### **Pupil Premium - Key Objectives:**

- Engagement - to enable all pupils to access learning and overcome identified barriers to learning.
- Attainment and Achievement - to improve outcomes for pupils and bring attainment in line with expected levels of progress and age related expectations, closing the gap through the provision of timely interventions.
- Curriculum - to enable all pupils access to a broad and balanced curriculum and not be disadvantaged in any way.
- Attendance - to implement strategies to support all pupils in meeting attendance targets and closing the gap between the attendance of children receiving pupil premium and those who are not.

#### **The Governors targeted the PPG to;**

- a) Provide small group/1:1 intervention work to ensure that attainment and achievement is in line with expected levels of progress
- b) To provide small group and 1:1 support for targeted children through interventions delivered by teachers or teaching assistants
- c) Working with parents through Assertive Mentoring (Attitude and Attendance criteria) to engage them in supporting their child and to improve their attitude and attendance.
- d) To enable pupils to access a wide range of opportunities and experiences in school (including after-school clubs), educational visits and outdoor and adventurous activities and not be disadvantaged.
- e) Third Space Learning Numeracy Intervention for identified pupils in Y6
- f) Booster Sessions led by HLTA for identified Y6 pupils
