

<u>Breakfast Club and Rainbow Club Behaviour Policy</u> <u>Created by Leanne Hedley & Jean Stewart - November</u> 2020, updated March 2022

Behaviour should be the same as it is in school and rules should be followed however we do understand that some children may need some support in managing their behaviour.

We expect:

- Children to be honest, kind and respectful.
- Children to look after toys and equipment.
- Children to listen to adults and each other.
- Children to use good manners.

UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR

Staff will try to meet children's needs as much as possible but will take action if a child's behaviour is going to result in causing harm or injury and if they are stopping other children attending from being able to enjoy their time.

- All incidents will be treated individually, but serious incidents will be reported to the child's parents, class teacher and headteacher.
- Staff will communicate in a clear, calm and positive manner and facilitate regular and open discussions with children about their behaviour to help them to understand and to also have their say.
- We will use the same behaviour ladder as school. If your child's behaviour is unacceptable, they will be given a verbal warning. If it continues, they will be given 5 minutes time out. If this is a regular occurrence, then you will be contacted.
- If a parent/carer is contacted about their child's behaviour, it is expected that they collect their child from the session as soon as possible.
- If your child's behaviour does not improve, they will then be unable to attend the following day.
- If there are still no improvements, your child will be unable to attend for 1 week. If it then still continues, your child could lose their place permanently.
