## Learning Highlights from Spring 2022:

### **World Book Day**

On world book day we all had great fun dressing up as one of our favourite characters and reading lots of fantastic stories.

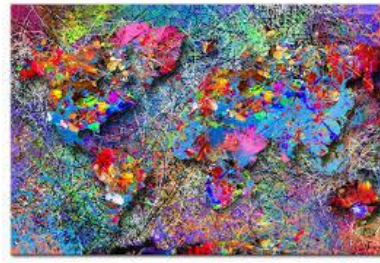
## PE

## New Learning Highlights Summer 2022

At the start of the Summer term we are going to explore the work of a range of artists and try to recreate their masterpieces using different techniques. We will go into our outdoor environment to make natural art in the style of Goldsworthy, we will do some circle printing to recreate Kandinsky's famous 'Concrete Squares and Circles', and we will do some large scale splattering art in the style of Pollock!

We will be learning about the author Eric Carle who also wrote "The Very Hungry Caterpillar". Eric Carle draws the pictures and writes the story - he is an author and illustrator. This fabulous book will support our topic for the Summer term, "Growing and Changing".

## PE

In physical development we are focusing on movement and dance as well as preparing for sports day with lots of team games. We will continue to develop fine motor skills with daily finger gym challenges and handwriting lessons.

Children need to wear their PE kit to school every Monday and Wednesday, in the Summer term. Weather permitting we will have our PE sessions outdoors and for health and safety reasons your child needs to wear trainers or plimsolls on PE days.

### **Homework Expectations**

In FS2, the focus of homework is on the importance skill of reading. Regular reading at home, especially reading with a parent/carer, should be encouraged. We feel passionately that the most significant thing that you, as parent/carer, can do to support your child's learning is to share books with them on a regular basis. By this we mean reading to your child, listening to your child read and talking about what you are reading.

Your child will bring home their book of choice on a Monday, this book is for you to share with your child. On Wednesday your child will bring home their reading book, your child should spent short periods of time (10-15 minutes) each day reading and talking about their reading book.
