
## Class Page

We learnt geographical skills, using atlases to locate South America and the countries and capitals of South America. We also compared life in the Brazilian Favelas with life in Northallerton.


In DT, we designed and made our own cardboard houses, complete with lights!





We produced these lovely, colourful pictures based on the art of Domingos Cardosa da Silva:







We explored different forces and the concepts of balance and counter balance, as Phillipe Petit himself would have experienced all of those forces as he walked his tightrope between the towers.


We tested air resistance by creating parachutes and designed and made balancing toys.

## New Learning Highlights Summer 22



To start the Summer term, we will be using 'Beowulf' by Michael Morpurgo, another exciting and beautifully illustrated book. We will be learning about the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings, and how their legacy has affected life in Britain today.

In Science, we will be exploring plants and germination. We hope to grow lots of plants in the classroom whilst exploring the conditions that support plant growth and finding out more about the functions of the different parts of plants and flowers.

In Maths, we will continue to use White Rose resources to support our learning. Key focus areas will include calculating with decimals, area and perimeter, shape and statistics.
