Learning Highlights from Autumn 22:


English:



In the Autumn 1 half term, we were learning about the Victorians. In English we looked at Major Glad, Major Dizzy by Jan Oke and A Guinea Pig Oliver Twist by Alex Goodwin. The children have worked very hard and done lots of super writing. The children created their own fact file about Guinea Pigs and wrote a character description of Major Glad and Major Dizzy.

Maths:

In maths, the children have covered various mathematical concepts such as place value and addition. We have been learning our number bonds and fact families within 10. The children can use a part whole model and are able to write number sentences. We have also learned how to write and read numbers as words.





Science:

In science, the class have learned which materials float and sink. We used the story, The Stickman, to inspire the children to create a raft that would float and stop stick man from sinking.

History:

In History, the children really enjoyed learning about the lives of Victorian's. The children were fascinated to learn that many Victorian children, the same age as them, would have to go to work each day. The children were particularly interested in the Victorian punishments used in Victorian schools such as the Cane and the Dunces hat. The children were able to identify the differences between their toys and those of Victorian children.


Geography:

In geography, we have learned about the 4 countries in the UK, their Capital Cities and their Flags. The children are now able to recognise important landmarks in our capital city London. We have named the five oceans.

PE:

In PE, we have been focusing on running. The children have played several games that focus on their running skills and even participated in a fun run against other schools! All children have thoroughly enjoyed both PE activities and have improved their skills and team work skills though different games. New Learning Highlights:

In the Autumn 2 term, we are looking at the books 'The Rabbit Problem' by Emily Garvett and 'Peter Rabbit' by Beatrix Potter.



Maths:

In maths, we will continue with our addition and subtraction topic before moving onto shape. Within the Shape topic we will learn to recognise, name and sort 3-D and 2-D shapes.

Science:

In science we are learning about the effects of temperature, why we have seasons and conducting an experiment to help us explore what freezing is and how polar bears keep warm.

Geography:

In Geography we are learning which is the hottest and coldest season in the UK and learning about weather patterns.

History:

In History, we are learning to reflect and record past events that have happened in our own History. We are also learning about the importance of Remembrance Day and why we wear the symbol of a poppy.



Key Class Reminders:

Pe Days: On Tuesday and Thursdays please come to school in PE kit.

Reading: The children are expected to read every night at home, even for just 5 minutes, and return their reading packet to school each day. Children take home a reading for pleasure book, which is their choice of book; they may not be able to read it so it can be enjoyed at home with an adult or older sibling. Children also take home their phonically decodable book, which they can read independently. Listening to your children read is so important to aid development.
