

"WHAT WILL MY CHILD BE LEARNING IN NURSERY THIS HALF TERM?"

- . LOTS of songs and rhymes, introducing new words and fun ways of counting! We will accompany our songs with signing too.
- . Counting out loud and quantifying objects in their play, beginning to understand amounts, recognise numerals and explain their thinking...working out simple problems too.
- . How to take turns and share resources (tricky!)
- . How to follow routines and understand classroom expectations; doing Good Looking, Good Listening and Good Sitting when they need to
- . How to express their needs verbally and use social manners appropriately with their friends and adults
- . How to access our classroom provision confidently and independently, choosing what to play with and becoming responsible for their own tidying -up too!
- . How to use different materials to create, following their own ideas and doing more structured tasks with an adult.
- . How to explore their environment and being bold enough to have a go at new things!
- . Becoming more independent in their own self-care; trying hard to do things for themselves AND helping others too!
- . Using different materials to Mark Make and explore meaning in their work - have a go at recognising and writing their own name (tricky but a HUGE achievement when they can do it!). Learning some Letter Sounds using the school Phonics Scheme
- . Have fun, make friends and learn away from home in a caring and nurturing environment!
