Phonics
We follow Little Wandle

Mathematics
We will be matching and sorting objects by their colour and size and making comparisons. We will copy continue and create simple repeating patterns. In number we will subitise or count and match number names to numerals and quantities. When counting we will touch every object and recognise that the final number we say names the quantity of the set.
