

Breakfast Club and Rainbow Club Policy



Breakfast Club

- Our breakfast club is currently funded through Broadacres and Greggs and is available for 3-11 year olds.
- Breakfast club operates from 7.45am - 8.40am(KS2) and 7.45am - 8.45am(KS1). The children are in their classroom for the start of the school day.
- Breakfast club is run in each hall - KS2 children enter through the KS2 main entrance and KS1 children enter through the door by the side of the kitchen.
- Staff tick children in on the register when they arrive. KS1 children should be brought by an adult. KS2 children are to be brought by an adult too unless in year 5/6 and this has been agreed. Adults should wait to see that their child has got into the school building.
- Booking should be done using the weekly booking form and parents should inform staff if their child no longer needs their place.

Children have a choice of cereal or toast with butter, lemon curd or jam with a drink of water or juice. We also cater for any dietary requirements. At Breakfast Club, children can socialise with their peers as well as completing word searches and similar activities.

Rainbow Club

- Rainbow Club operates from the end of the school day until 5.30pm.
- Staff sign the children out when they leave with the time they have been collected.
- Booking should be done using the weekly booking form and parents should inform staff if their child's place is no longer required. If parents do not inform staff of cancellation, they will still be charged.

At Rainbow Club, children are provided with fun, stimulating and age-appropriate activities that will help them to develop their skills. They will also have a small snack and drink each night.
